

Updates from the Cameron Station Civic Association

The Cameron Station Civic Association is a neighbor-led group committed to keeping residents informed and advocating for our community's interests. From city policies and development projects to traffic, public safety, and green space, the Civic Association monitors meetings, events, and initiatives that may impact life in and around Cameron Station.

Spring 2026: Expected to occur early this Spring, trail improvements in Ben Brenman Park are coming! Improvements will include fitness equipment, trees, and shrubs. The approved fitness equipment includes a three-person combo fitness station, parallel bars and an exercise bench. The City will install a handful of native trees and plants, including both ornamental trees and larger shade trees. The improvements are the result of a survey conducted in 2025. Exterior Modification Applications Information

Residents are **required** per the **Design & Maintenance Standards** to submit an application for approval from the Architectural Review Committee prior to making any exterior modification to your home or lot. **Click here** for more information.

It is important to note the upcoming ARC meeting dates and the application due date/time for your request. If there are questions, information, and/or documents that are not received by the application due date, your application will be scheduled for the following month (based on finalizing your application).

If you submit an external modification application, it is important **to attend the ARC meeting at which your application will be considered**, via Zoom. The meeting link is located on the **ARC webpage**, and these meetings are open to all residents. If specific questions arise and the ARC does not have sufficient information regarding your application, it will be tabled to a future meeting until all questions are answered and the ARC has a full understanding of your home project.


